

In the wake of tragic events, like the act of terror that killed 14 people and injured many more in San Bernardino California, AW Tozer's daily devotional was especially timely on Thursday. My friend Kyle Rigsby, brought my attention to it via text message. Check it out:

DECEMBER 3

GOD'S PROMISE WILL OUTLIVE MAN'S VIOLENCE

Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.
2 PETER 3:17

Those who still read and trust their Bibles in the midst of the nuclear age have found a great truth and a message the rest of the world does not know: after the warlords have shot their last missile and dropped their last bomb there will still be living men inhabiting this globe!

After the world has gone through the meat grinder of Armageddon the earth will still be inhabited by men; not by biological freaks, but by real people like you and me. If the world can escape annihilation only by adopting the ethics of Jesus, as some think, we may as well resign ourselves to the inevitable explosion, for a huge block of the earth's population is controlled by Communists whose basic ideology is violently anti-Christian and who are determined to extirpate every trace of Christianity from among them. Other large blocks are non-Christian and grimly set to remain so.

MISSION: KENYA

At the end of October, I left for a 10 day trip to Nairobi, Kenya. I was with Arch and Sherry Bonema, who are very good family friends of ours and a lot like grandparents to me.



While I was there, we visited an orphanage in the town, a "children's home" is what it is called there. Along with that, we visited the church and were able to see the fruit of many things the Bonemas had started before they left Africa the last time. We also were able to attend an ordination service in Nairobi!

My favorite part of the trip was FOR SURE the orphanage! I instantly fell in love with all of the kids. Two in particular- John and Leon - were both around 4 years old and were very special to me. The kids we visited were very well cared for and were taught the gospel day in and day out! This orphanage we visited is trying to expand to care for around 100 more children.



At first, the poverty in Africa really hit me hard. I never expected what I saw, and could never explain it. My thoughts immediately went to "what can I do? Shoes, food,etc? " But as I took time to soak it all in, God reminded me that food, shelter, and money, are all temporary. It doesn't matter if we are the wealthiest people alive, without the Gospel, it is worth nothing.

Of course, they do need help with temporal things. That's important. But what they need most, what we need most, what this world needs most, is the Gospel.

As we look back at the first coming of the Lord, we also look forward to the second coming of Christ. This tension of looking back and looking forward is sometime referred to as the "already but not yet".


