The GBF Student Ministry recently went on its annual mission trip to Pine Hill Church on the Navajo Indian Reservation in northwest New Mexico. The theme verse for this year's trip was Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek." We should always strive to be unashamed of the gospel of Jesus Christ. This past week, our students lived this out. They boldly taught and shared the gospel by putting on a Vacation Bible School at Pine Hill Church for the local Navajo kids. I witnessed our students boldly proclaim the gospel of Jesus, unconditionally love the Navajo children, and have a lot of fun doing so.

Over a five day period, we broke the gospel down into four parts: the holiness of God, the sinfulness of man, the sacrifice of Christ, and the right response. Our students stepped completely outside of their comfort zone and embraced all new challenges. Whether they were called upon to teach that day or to lead rec and snack out in the hot sun, our students worked their tail off each and every day to make sure that every Navajo child left knowing that they were loved by God and by us. From the moment the first kid jumped out of the van to the moment the last kid loaded up in the van to leave for the day, our students were totally engaged. No child was made to feel like an outcast. Every child was able to walk away from VBS knowing that someone else cares for the well-being of their soul. Not because they have some alternative motive, but because they genuinely love them.

We established 3 pillars to determine how we facilitate VBS. First and foremost, we were to be gospel-centered. If we spend the entire week on the reservation, but we never speak the truth, we miss the mark. Second, we were to be relational. Information best travels across bridges of trust. We set out to build relationships in the name of Jesus. Lastly, we were going to have fun. Fun is a universal language that everyone understands and everyone enjoys. If we can laugh with one another, we can learn from one another. Our students executed this to perfection. We have an amazing group of students and I was truly blessed to be able to serve with them on the NM Mission Trip of 2016. We did it for the turn-up. It was lit.
